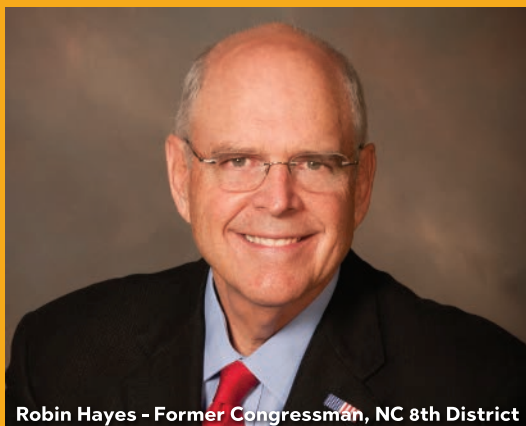


**Terri Pope – Vice President,  
Hub Operations, Charlotte (Retired)**

As vice president of Hub Operations in Charlotte for American Airlines, Pope led all aspects of American's second-largest hub and one of the country's busiest airports. American has more than 11,000 employees based in Charlotte. Pope has more than four decades of experience in the airline industry. She began her career at US Airways working for Air Kentucky Airlines. Pope worked her way up within US Airways, serving in various management roles at Boston Logan International Airport; New York's LaGuardia Airport; West Palm Beach, Fla., and Washington, D.C.'s Reagan National Airport. She became the first female

airport Director in the history of US Airways and was promoted to oversee the Charlotte hub in 2000. Pope serves on the Board of Directors for the Renaissance West Community Initiative, the Charlotte Douglas Airport Chaplaincy, and the Airport Community Partnership. Pope and her husband Barry live in Mooresville and have a son, David.

A native of Concord, NC, Hayes is President of the Cannon Charitable Trust and a Director of the Cannon Foundation. He has served on the Board of Directors of The US Air Force Academy, The Childress Institute for Pediatric Trauma, the USO of North Carolina, The Healing Place of Wake County, and on the Board of Advisors for the J. Dennis Hastert Center at Wheaton College. Robin served in the U.S House of Representatives from 1998 – 2009, where he was a member of Agriculture and Transportation committees. As a senior member of the Armed Services Committee, he served as a strong and consistent voice for our men and women in uniform. Hayes served on the Concord Board of Aldermen from 1976 until 1980, was elected to the NC House in 1992, and was the Republican nominee for Governor in 1996. Robin is a pilot with both private and commercial licenses. He and his wife Barbara have two children and seven grandchildren.
